

Personal data policy

With this information, the Revenue Agency explains how it uses the collected data you provided and what are the rights recognized by the EU Regulation 2016/679.

Your personal data will be processed by the Agency exclusively for the purposes related to the publishing of the articles you sent. Your personal data will not be disseminated except for the purposes for which you have given your consent. However, if necessary, they may be disclosed:

- to subjects to whom data must be disclosed in fulfilment of an obligation imposed by law, by a regulation or by Community legislation, or to fulfil an order of the Judicial Authority;
- to subjects designated by the data controller, as Data Officers or persons authorised to process personal data operating under the direct authority of the data controller or the data officer;
- To any other third party, in cases expressly provided for by law, or if the communication becomes necessary for protecting the Agency in court, in compliance with the current provisions on the protection of personal data.

The Revenue Agency implements appropriate measures to ensure personal data are appropriately processed in accordance with the purposes for which they are managed; the Revenue Agency employs appropriate security organizational, technical and physical measures to protect information from alteration, destruction, loss, theft or improper or illegitimate use.

The personal data processing controller is the Revenue Agency, based in Rome, while Sogei S.p.A., based in Rome is a technological partner entrusted with the management of the IT system of the Taxation Register, as "data processing manager".

You have the right, at all times, to confirm whether such data exists or not and / or to verify their use. Furthermore, you have the right to request, in accordance with the law, the correction of any inaccurate personal data and the integration of incomplete personal data. In cases provided by the regulation, without prejudice to the arrangements laid down for certain treatments, you may also request the deletion of data, after the conservation period or the restriction of processing. The opposition to the processing, for reasons connected to your particular situation, is allowed unless there are legitimate reasons for the continuation of the collection.
